2. Purpose and legal basis of the processing of personal data as well as processed personal data

The State Ministry of Justice and for Democracy, Europe and Equality and the EUD Saxony process personal data on the basis of the consent of relevant person to the processing for specific purposes (planning, implementation and follow-up of the event "Ventotene Forum 2022"), Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. a Basic Data Protection Regulation. The consent given can be revoked at any time. However, this does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent until the revocation. A revocation of the consent before the event, however, leads to the participation of the person concerned in the event not being possible.

Name, first name, title, e-mail address, address, telephone number, date of birth will be deleted one year after the end of the event at the latest. The storage for one year after the end of the event serves the purpose of inviting to the follow-up event in the next year.

Sound and image recordings will be stored permanently for the purpose of public relations in connection with the event and will be deleted if the consent is revoked.

All other data will be deleted as soon as they are no longer required for the purpose of their collection, but no later than twelve weeks after the end of the event.

Apart from that, all personal data will be deleted immediately if the consent is revoked.

Automated decision-making will not take place.

3. passing on of data

The following data (title, first name, last name, e-mail address, JEF/EUD membership, membership of marginalized group, telephone number, date of birth) will be passed on to JEF Italy for the organization of the event (in particular: selection of applicants in case of more than 50 registrations, organization of arrival and departure, confirmation of participation, evaluation of the event). Limited data (title, first name, surname, address) will be passed on to the staff of the accommodation to be booked. Photographs will be forwarded for public relations purposes to JEF Italy, Forum MIDEM, the Cofassoziacioni Young World and the Sächsische Landeszentrale für politische Bildung (SLpB). Beyond that a passing on of the data to third is not intended.

Within the State Ministry of Justice and for Democracy, Europe and Equality only those persons are granted access to the personal data who are entrusted with their processing for the processing purposes described above.

4. data subject rights

As data subject, you have the following rights if the legal requirements are met:

- The right to information about personal data concerning you (Article 15 General Data Protection Regulation)
- The right to have inaccurate personal data concerning you corrected (Article 16 General Data Protection Regulation)

- The right to erasure of personal data (Article 17 Data Protection basic regulation)
- The right to restriction of the processing of personal data (Article 18 General Data Protection Regulation)
- The right to data portability (Article 20 Basic Data Protection Regulation).

You also have the right to object to the processing of personal Data (Article 21 of the General Data Protection Regulation).

Requests to this effect should be addressed to the data controllers.

Pursuant to Article 77 of the General Data Protection Regulation, you also have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority, such as the Saxon Data Protection Commissioner, Kontor am Landtag, Devrientstraße 1, 01067 Dresden, if you are of the opinion that the processing of the personal data concerning you is not lawful.

The provision of personal data is neither required by law nor by contract.

You are not obliged to provide the personal data. Failure to provide the mandatory data may however, have the consequence that participation in the event is not possible.

Data protection consent

By registering for this event, I agree that the Saxonian Saxon State Ministry of Justice and for Democracy, Europe and Equality (SMJusDEG) and EUD Saxony may collect, store and use the personal data I have provided (by e-mail, for internal electronic storage at the office of the Europa-Union Deutschland - Landesverband Sachsen e.V. and Junge Europäische Föderalist:innen - Landesverband Sachsen e.V. (EUD/JEF Saxony), at the Junge Europäische Föderalist:innen Italien (JEF Italy) and for the booking of the accommodations) for the for the purpose of the organization, realization and follow-up of the event "Ventotene-Forum 2022".

The purpose includes:

- booking and allocation of accommodation
- division of discussion groups
- booking of public transport tickets if person-related
- organization of arrival and departure (flat-rate arrangement)

- Confirmation of participation and transmission of information in the run-up to the event, queries if necessary
- evaluation of the event.

The purpose also includes public relations work accompanying the event.

Regarding the public relations work accompanying the event, I agree that during the event during the event, visual and audio recordings of me are taken. The pictures and recordings will be used for public relations, especially in social media of the SMJusDEG and in the forms of publication mentioned below, but may also be used at a later date for other public relations measures in connection with the Ventotene Forum.

I am aware that the images taken of me for this purpose will be used in the following forms of publication:

- Intranet pages and Internet presences of the SMJUsDEG, the EUD/JEF Saxony, the Junge Europäische Föderalist:innen Italien (JEF Italy), of the Forum MIDEM, of the Cofassoziacioni Young World, the Sächsische Landeszentrale für politische Bildung (SLpB);
- Social media channels of the Saxon state government (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter) and social media channels of the Saxon State Ministry of Justice and for Democracy, Europe and Equality, the EUD/JEF Saxony and the JEF Italy, the Forum MIDEM, the Cofassoziacioni Young World, the SLpB;
- E-mail newsletter of EUD/JEF Saxony and JEF Italy;
- Print publications.

I grant the Saxon State Ministry of Justice and for Democracy, Europe and the EUD Saxony an unlimited right of use of the recordings in terms of time and space.

The right of use can be sublicensed. The right of use is unrestricted and includes in particular, but not exclusively, the following types of use: publication on the Internet and in print media for both promotional and editorial purposes, storage in image databases.

The rights to publish the images shall be granted without remuneration and includes a right to edit, provided that these image changes are not distorting.

In particular, this includes the right to retouch, enlarge, and crop the images and to insert them into other images (photomontage).

I agree that the images may be passed on in the context of reporting to newspaper publishers, broadcasters, other media companies, press agencies and journalists in the

context of reporting. The names of the persons depicted will be treated confidentially. The names will not be passed on to third parties.

I am aware that the images can be accessed worldwide when they are published on the Internet or in social networks and can be found in particular by search engines.

Further use and/or alteration by third parties cannot be ruled out and under certain circumstances, complete deletion on the Internet is not possible.

I am aware that the publication of the images in social networks may result in the data transfer to the United States of America (USA). With regard to the U.S., the European Commission has not yet determined an adequate level of data protection (Art. 45 of the General Data Protection Regulation). There are currently no suitable safeguards in terms of data protection law (Art. 46 General Data Protection Regulation). With regard to the data transferred to the U.S., there is a risk that third parties, including U.S. authorities, may have access to this data. There is also a greater likelihood of incorrect data processing, as the technical and organizational measures for the protection of personal data do not fully comply with the requirements of European data protection law. In the U.S.A., there may also be no effective legal protection with regard to data protection. **In view of the existing possible risks of such data transfers without the existence of an adequacy decision and without suitable appropriate safeguards, I expressly consent to the transfer of data to the USA.**

As far as ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership or genetic, biometric data for identification, health data or data relating to sexual life or sexual orientation are affected, the consent also refers explicitly to the use of these data for the above-mentioned purposes.

The consent is voluntary. I am aware that without the specification of my e-mail address my registration cannot be accepted. Without indication of name, first name, e-mail address no booking of accommodation can be made. Without telephone number, my participation cannot be finally confirmed, if I could not be reached via e-mail. I can revoke my consent at any time with effect for the future. The lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent is not affected by the revocation. I am

aware that a revocation of my consent prior to the event regularly leads to the fact that I can no longer participate in the event.
